Habitat Explorers

Explore and compare two different habitats (pond, grassland or woodland). Find out about the creatures that live there. Includes life cycles, adaptations, food chains, teamwork & data collection.

Micro Monster Hunt

Using special techniques, search for invertebrates on land and in water. Learn about adaptations, food chains, camouflage and how insects impact the environment.

Wild at Art

Investigate the natural world and get creative with a wide range of materials. Study shapes, textures, and colours and create your very own work of art!

Forest Skills

Get out into the woods and discover the natural world around you. Work together to make decisions & manage risk while you explore your surroundings. Then try your hand at shelter building and fire lighting.

Team Challenge

Work in teams to navigate yourselves through a series of challenges. Give your brains a workout at the toxic swamp, test your co-ordination on the crocodile skis and you'll need a steady hand to do well on the pipe run!
